# Japan's Entry to TPP Talk

After over a year of discussion, the White House has announced its approval of Japan's entry into the ongoing negotiations for the Trans Pacific Partnership (TPP). According to The Hill, Japan's entry into TPP negotiations is pending a consensus agreement with the other TPP members.

Following the announcement Friday morning, American Farm Bureau Federation (AFBF) President Bob Stallman said the AFBF is pleased with the decision of the U.S. to approve the addition of Japan as a negotiating partner in the TPP.

"As a major U.S. trading partner, Japan would bolster the reach of the TPP for U.S. agriculture," Stallman said. "As the fourth-largest U.S. agricultural export market, with nearly \$14 billion in purchases in 2012, trade with Japan is important to America's farmers and ranchers. Both the United States and Japan will benefit from Japan being a TPP partner, and by sharing in improved sanitary and phytosanitary standards for agricultural trade and expanded market access with TPP nations."

Stallman continued that the decision by Japan to increase access for U.S. beef "shows that Japan can act to improve market access for U.S. agricultural products based on sound science."
